

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Introduction

A WhiteWater invention, AquaCourse is a ground-breaking take on multi-level play structures that combines a patented close track harness safety system with a water-based ropes course. Guests are challenged to traverse between towers, along lily pad walks, and across a series of tricky and demanding bridges—all while safely harnessed in. Along the way, they'll encounter deluge showers, surprise geysers, and interactive water jets to keep them on their toes.

Designed with different zones for varying levels of difficulty and water saturation, AquaCourse's lower tracks are perfect for smaller kids, allowing them to feel safe, while higher tracks appeal to teens and adults who crave bigger thrills.

Winner of IAAPA's Brass Ring Award for best new product in 2012, we continue to innovate and perfect this award-winning attraction for new generations; making it an ideal attraction to diversify a park's water play mix.



AquaCourse Interactive and **Challenge Elements**

AquaCourse features a mix of water-based interactives and physical challenge elements. The range of interactives allows guests on the tracks to spray and splash each other by pulling ropes, pushing buttons, and stepping on foot activated jets. They can also get splashed by guests waiting in the interactive queue line, who can pull ropes to activate showers and shoot water blasters at them.

The challenge elements add thrills and another layer of complexity to AquaCourse, by creating tricky and tough obstacles, such as beams, bumper crosswalks, and turbo stirrups for guests to cross.

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AquaCourse is available in four models of varying sizes and configurations to meet the footprint and capacity needs of your water park. Each model features specially designed interactive zones for varying levels of challenge, thrill, and soak factor.



Just outside of the Interactive Queue Zone, spectators and parents can keep dry while keeping an eye on participants as they explore the structure.



Without traditional barriers, guests waiting in line can cool off with interactive handrails, tipping troughs and cones, and water blasters.

INNER INTERACTIVITY ZONE

Exclusive to the AC180, guests waiting in queue or simply looking to get in on the action can walk into the centre of the 'arena' to get sprayed with water and shoot water blasters are participants.




The heart of the action, this is the zone where guests, in harnesses, navigate across challenging obstacles, spray their fellow adventurers, and get soaked in return.
